The ABC of Château Cantenac Brown

For many years, the magnificent Grand Cru Classé of Château Cantenac Brown has been accompanied by BriO de Cantenac Brown, a special parcel selection from the Cantenac Brown vineyards, and also by Chateau Brown Lamartine, our Bordeaux Supérieur of upmost quality.

In 2011, our family expands with the addition of **AltO de Cantenac Brown**, our white wine.

We are fortunate to own a wonderful plot of clay and calcareous soil cool enough to produce a great white wine.

1.8 hectares are planted to Sauvignon Blanc (90%) and Semillon (10%) for a production of only 9,000 to 10,000 bottles a year.

We wished to make a wine taking after the great wines of Sancerre: a wine of great minerality, beautiful aroma, and a wine fit for the Gastronomical table.

Elegant and delicate, AltO pays homage to the art of music, while at the same time complimenting the entire Cantenac Brown gamut of wines. A perfect addition!



Technical Data :

Area: 1.8 hectares

Varieties: 90 % de Sauvignon Blanc
10 % de Sémillon

Vinification : Hand harvested in small crates with refrigerated transport,
Slow pressurization by inert gas, alcoholic fermentation in barrels

Ageing: 100% in one-year-old barrels
